

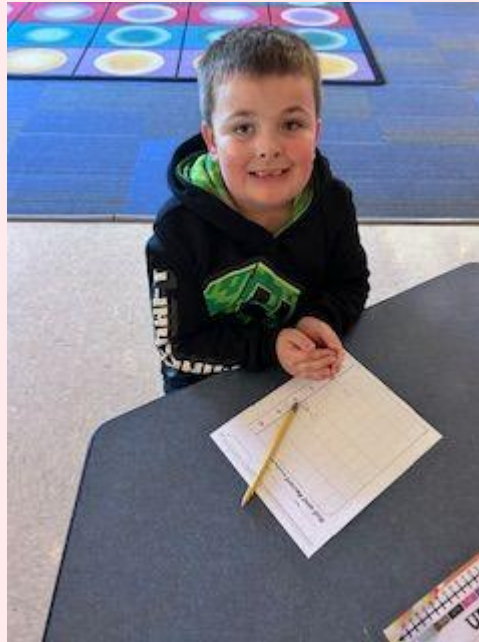
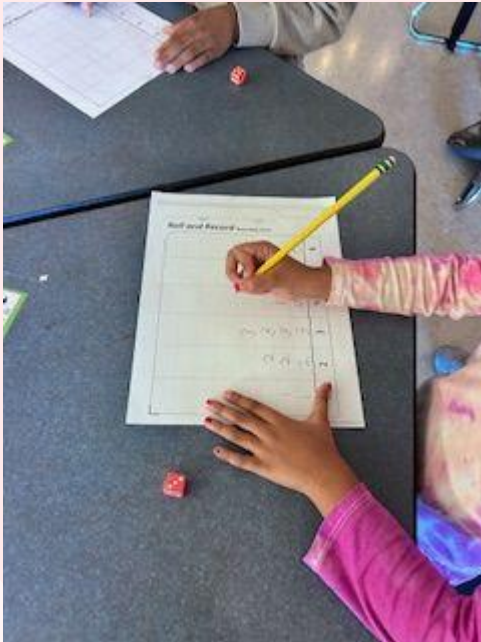

We learned a new game in math this week called roll and record! It helps us with counting, one-to-one correspondence and number writing!



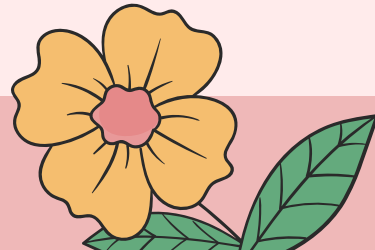
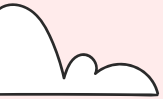
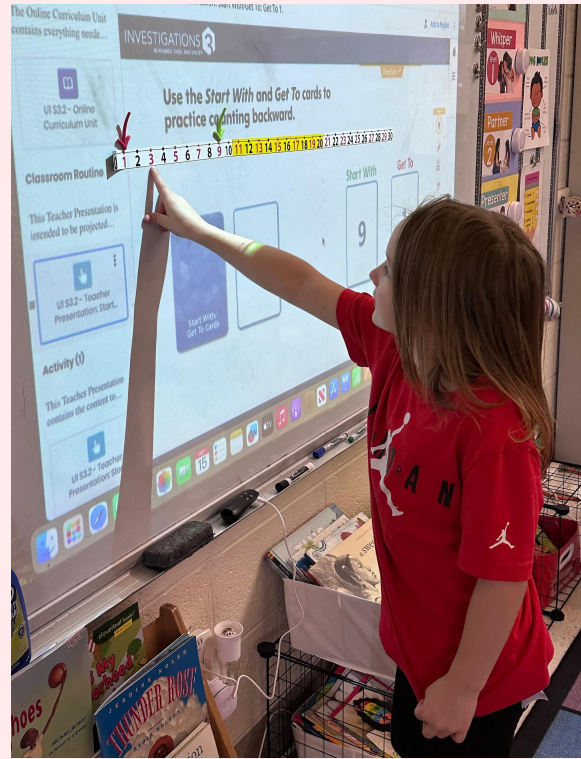
Mrs. Gorski

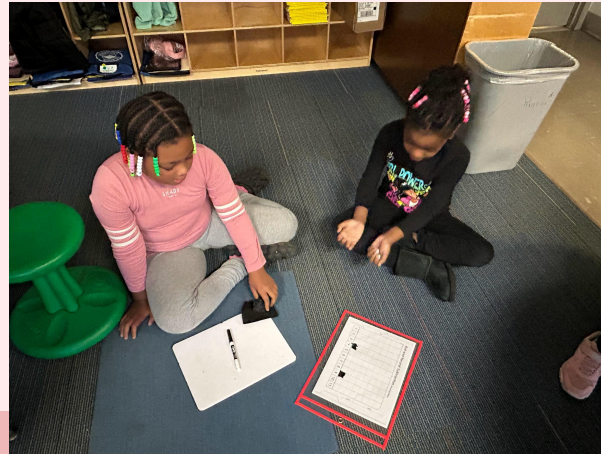
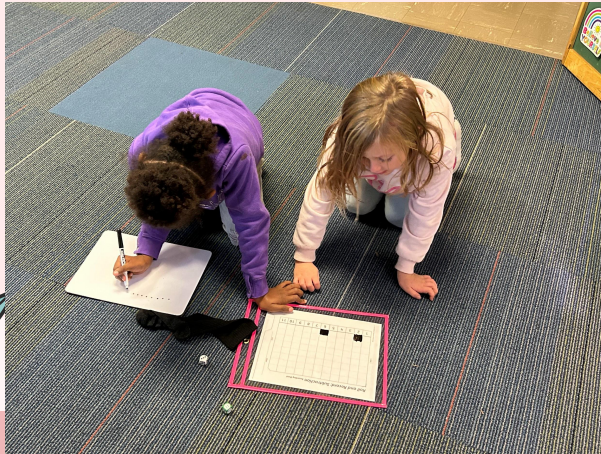
Mrs. Becker

This week we practiced counting backwards to help us with understanding subtraction. We played the game Start With Get To, but this time we had to count backward to get to the ending number.



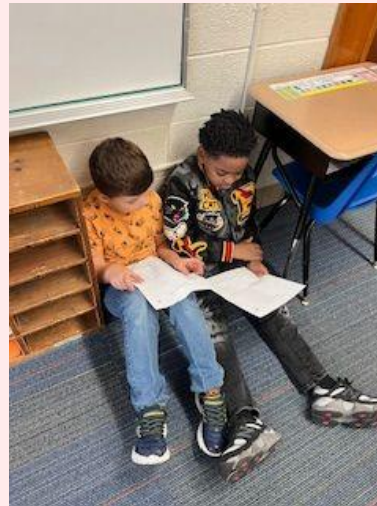

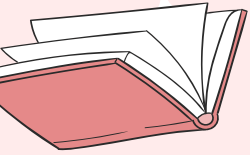
Students in our class have been working on using strategies for basic subtraction. We played Roll & Record to practice this skill.

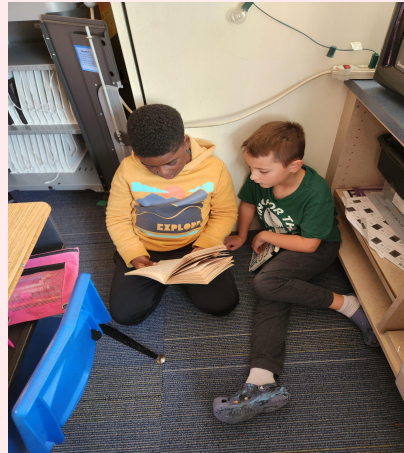
This week we grew as a community during our Morning Circle. We also enjoyed partner reading.





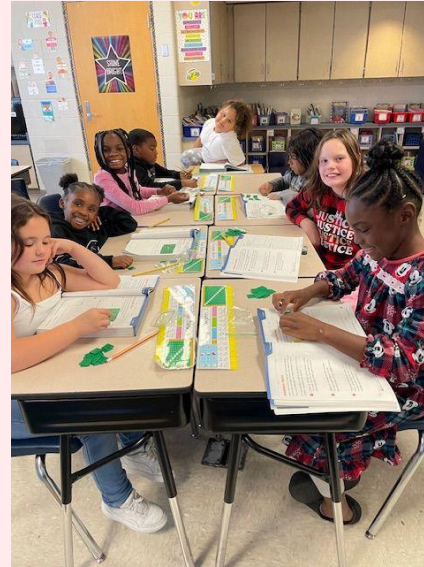
