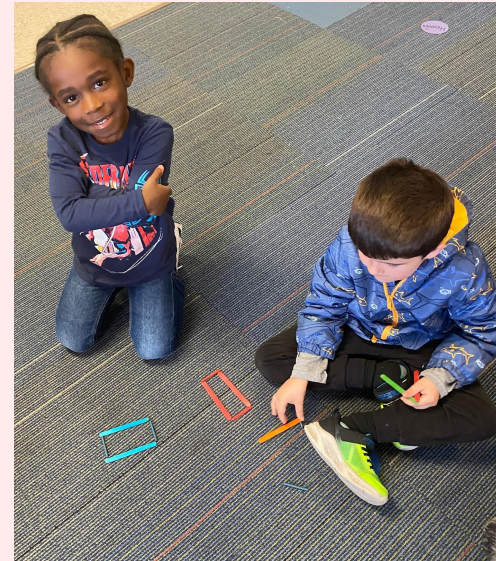

This week we used unifix cubes to help us count and practice our one to one correspondence and help us compare numbers!



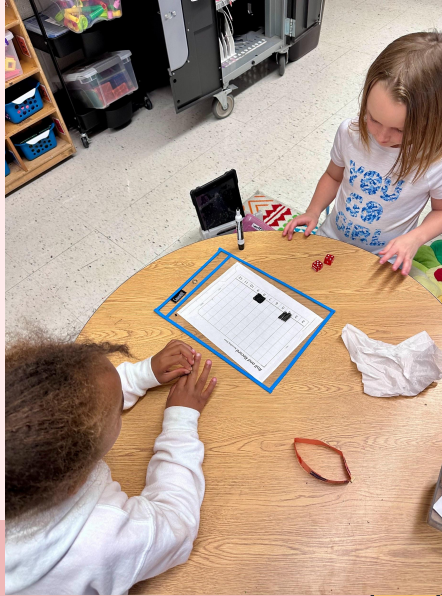
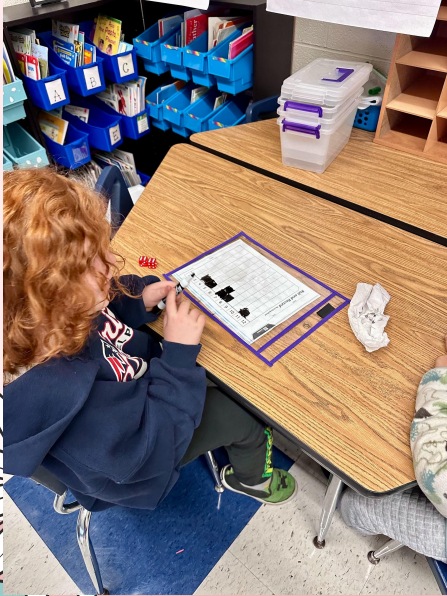
Mrs. Gorski

We learned a math game called Roll and Record. This game helps to practice counting and addition. Students roll both dice and add the two numbers together, then they record their answers on the game board.



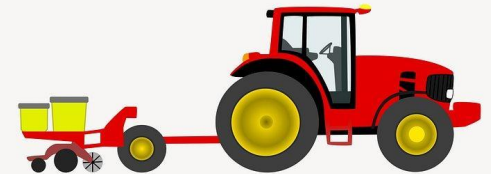

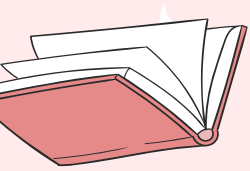
We have been working really hard on building our stamina during independent reading time!

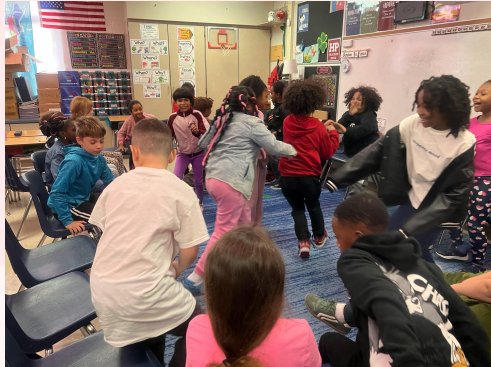
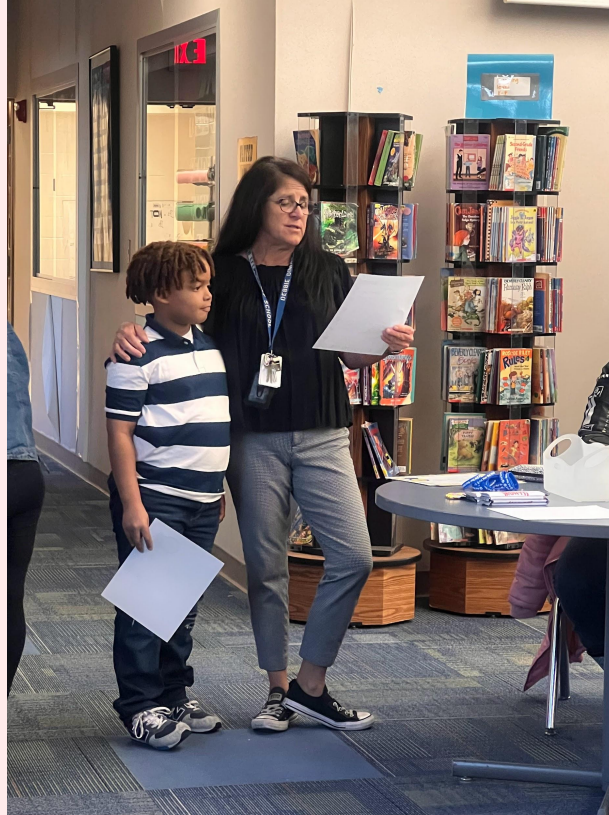

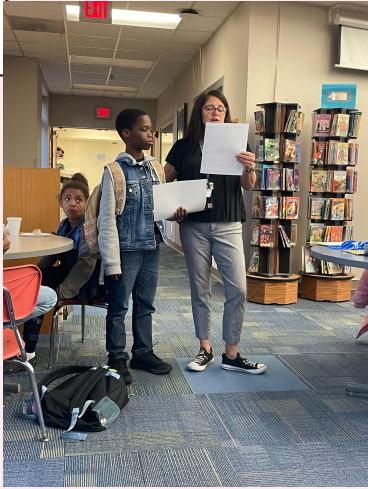

We had a lot of fun this week learning some new games during our morning meeting. We also celebrated our September Student of the Month: Jakobe!

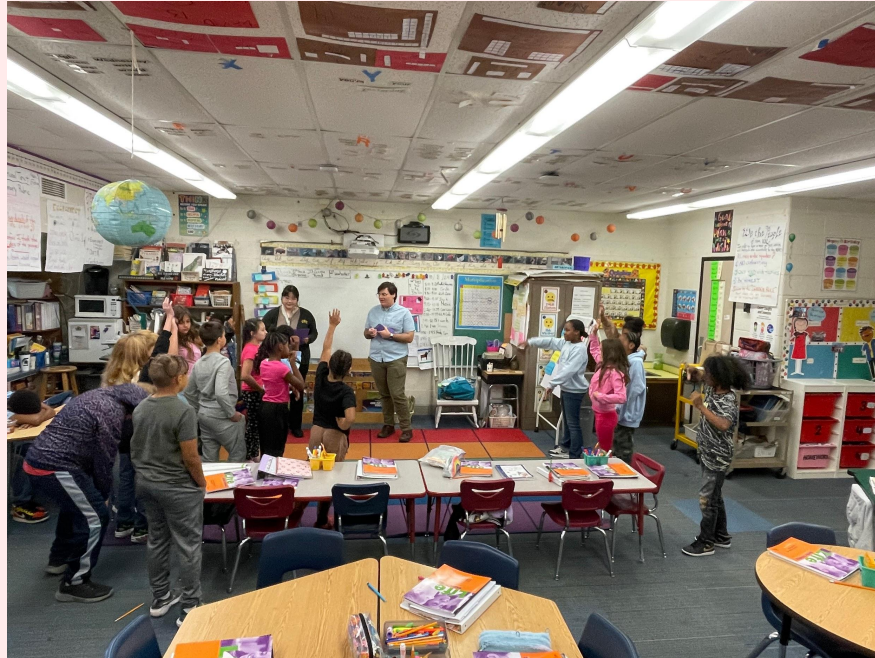

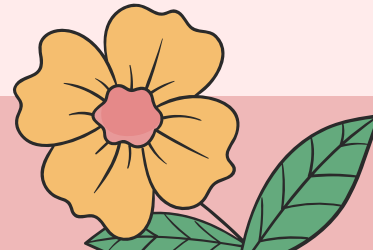
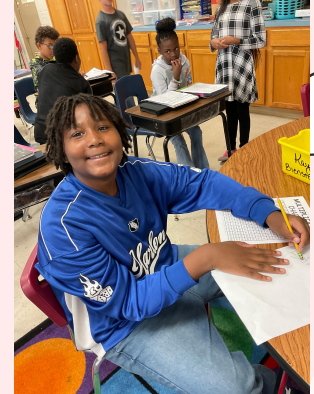
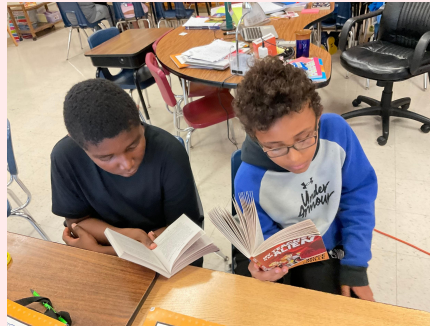
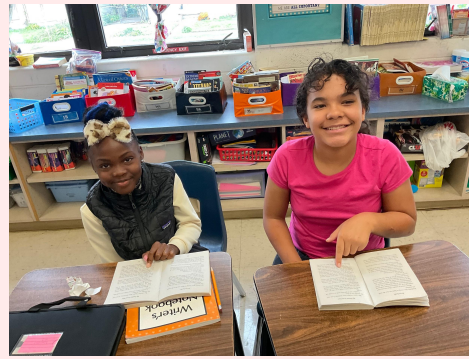


Enjoying this beautiful weather during recess. Practicing our patience with one another in the classroom and on the playground.
