This week in Kindergarten we enjoyed listening to and comparing different versions of the Gingerbread Man. We ended the week by making cute gingerbread crowns.

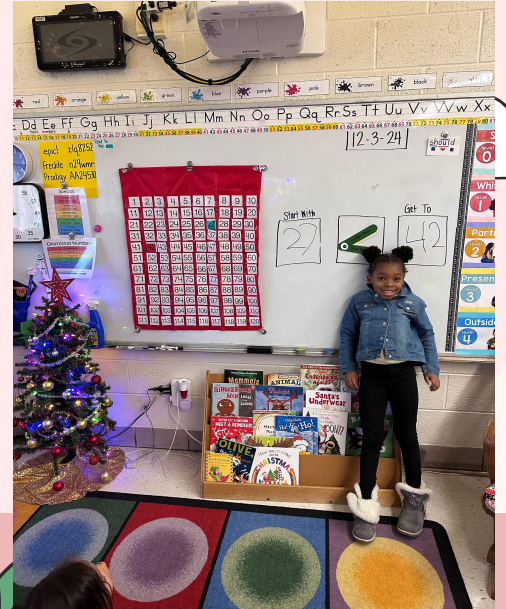

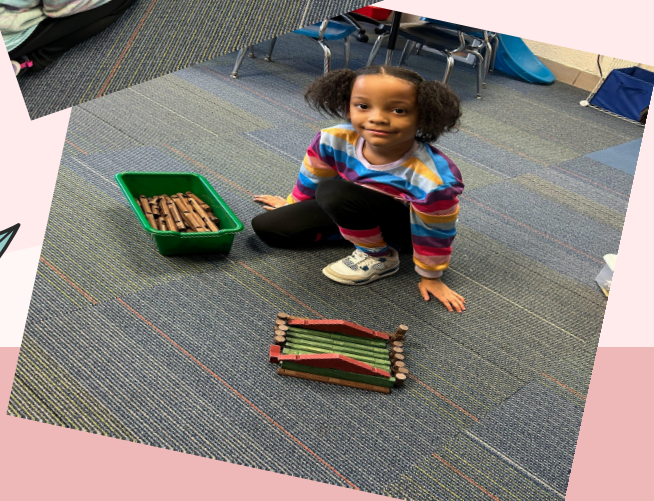
Mrs. Dimas read the book, Boxitects, to us on Zoom. We learned new vocabulary words and loved seeing the other classes on the zoom, as well.

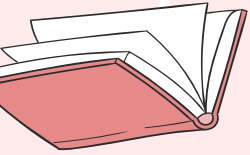

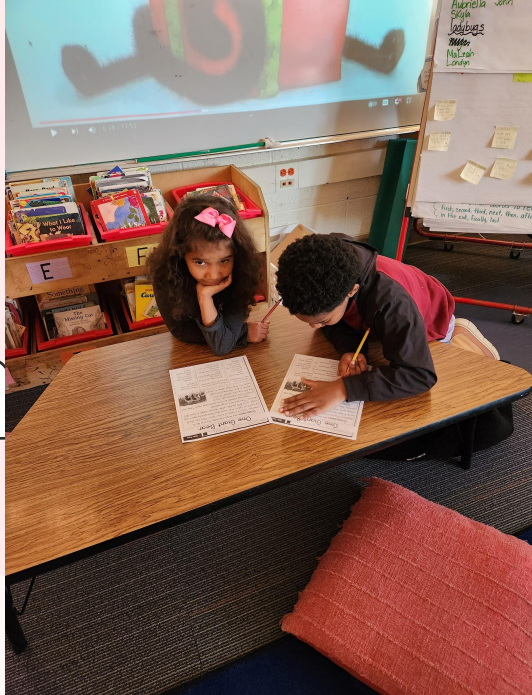

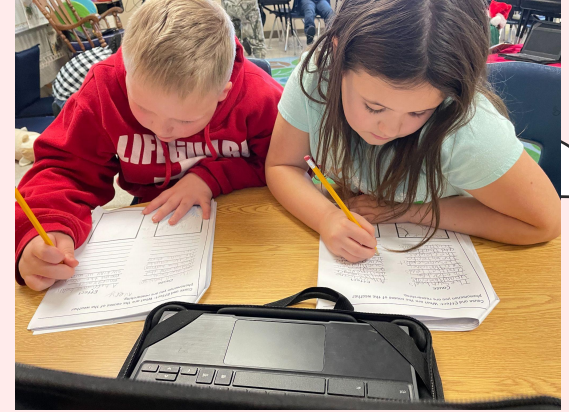

Students worked hard this week reading different passages and finding the main idea!

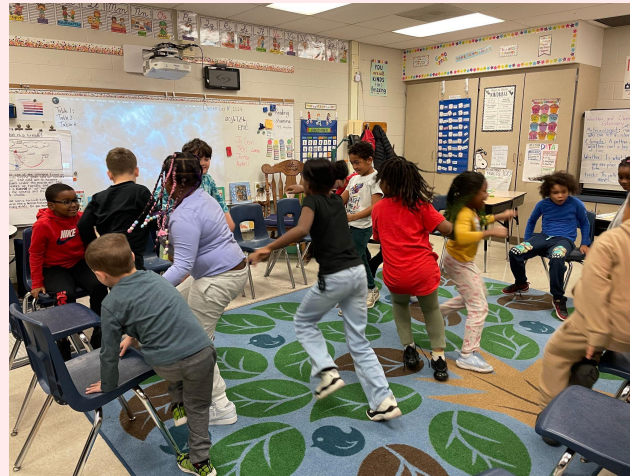

During our Language Arts unit, the class had the opportunity to pair up with a partner to research and report on a weather condition.



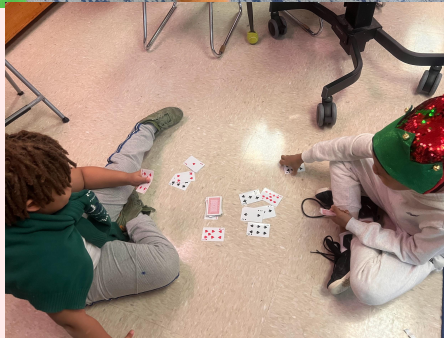
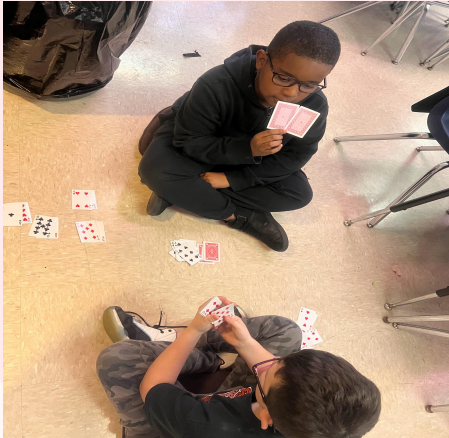
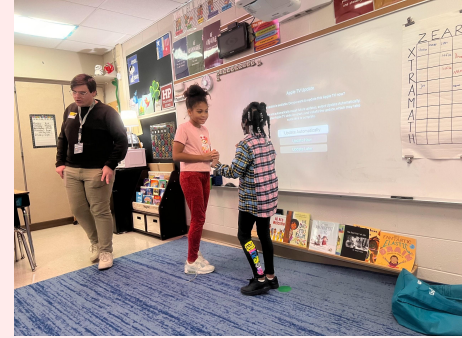
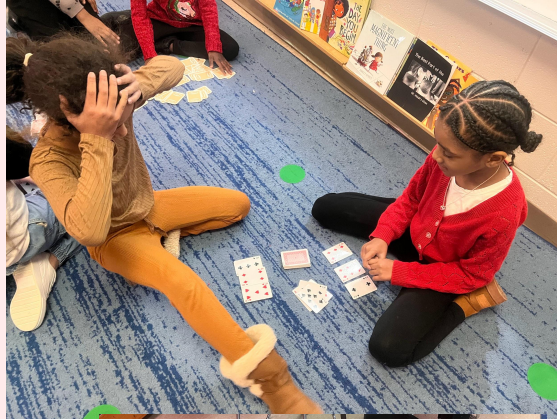
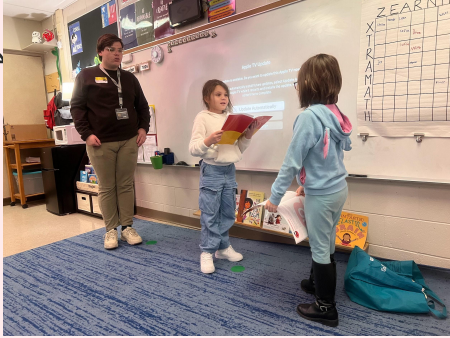
We had a pack meeting with our second grade class, and read the book *How to Lose Your Friends* and played the game Train Wreck in our sharing circle.





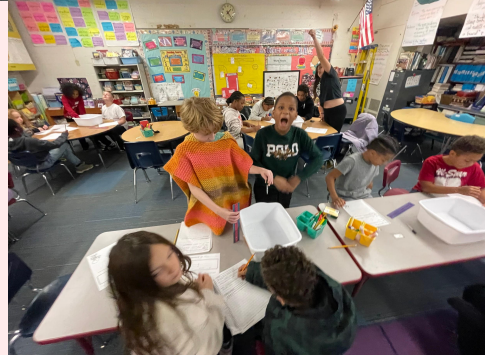
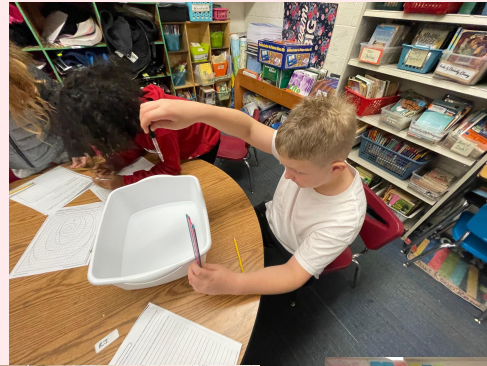

We had many great learning activities this week, but the favorite was a card game called, "Make 10". We also had our last life skills class and students had a lot of fun acting out scenarios.



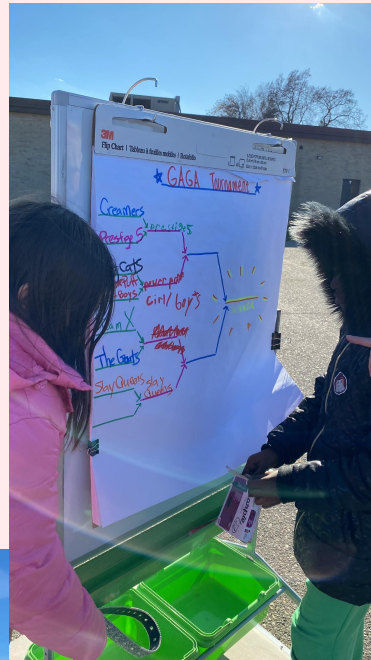
