

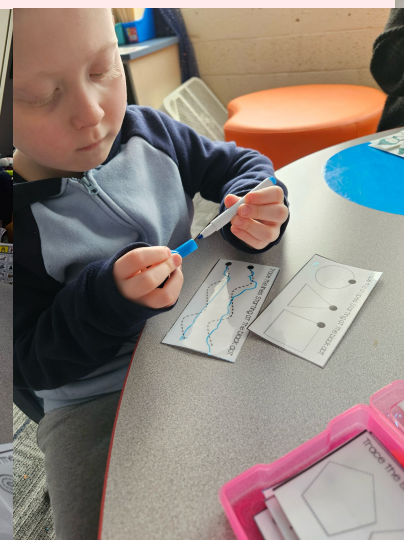
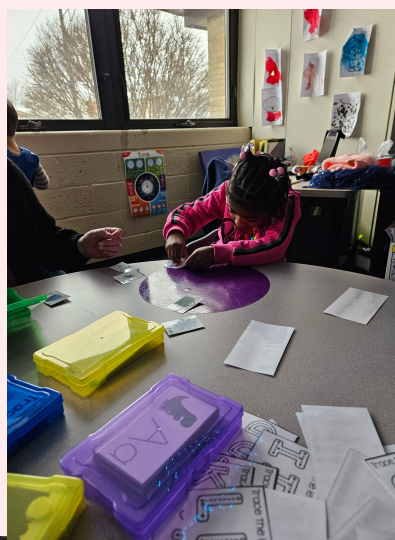

This week we worked on our writing and reading skills. We also matched objects in file folders. On Friday we used watercolors to paint.



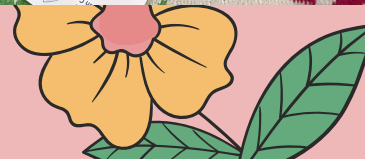
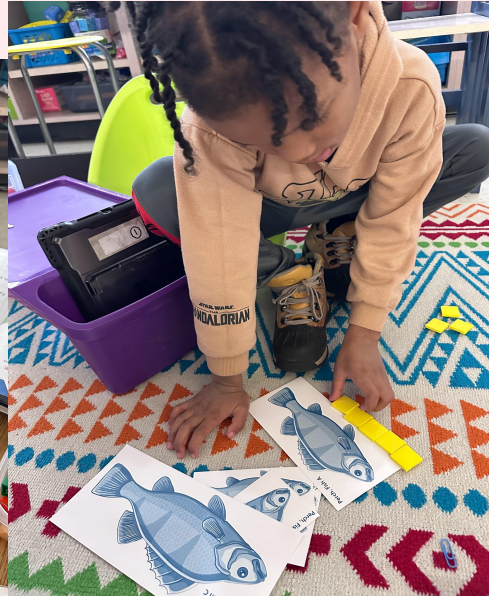
Mrs. Wohlfeill

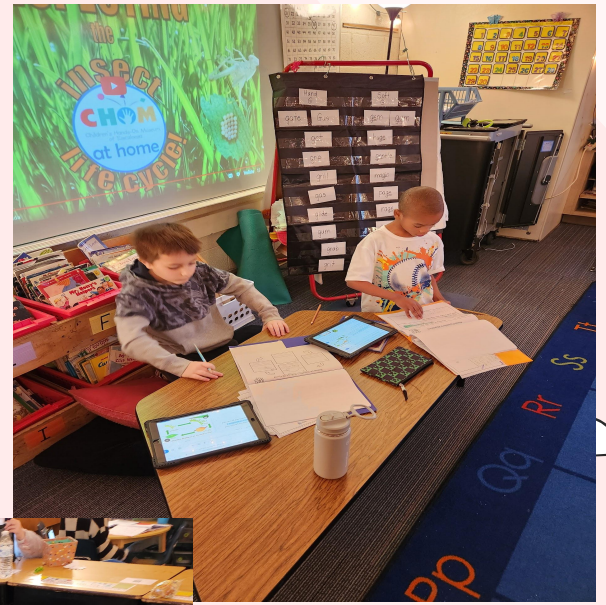
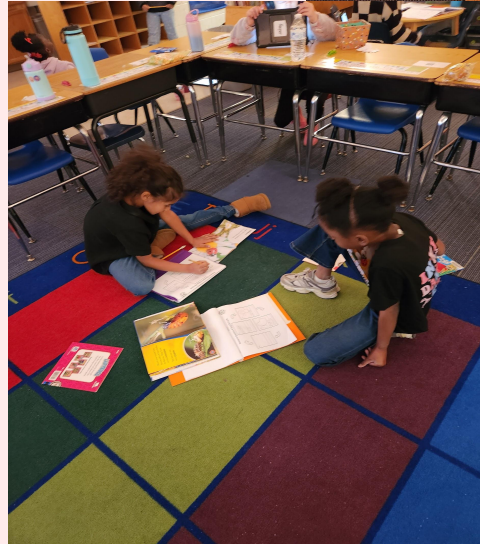
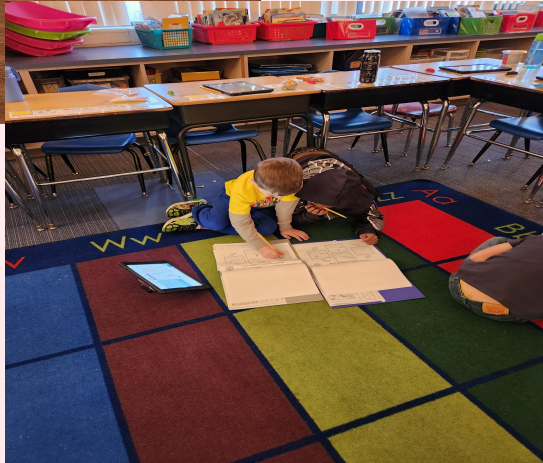
This week we researched our Bug's Life Cycle and how they interact with the environment!

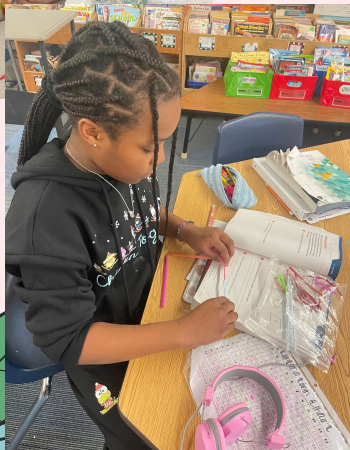
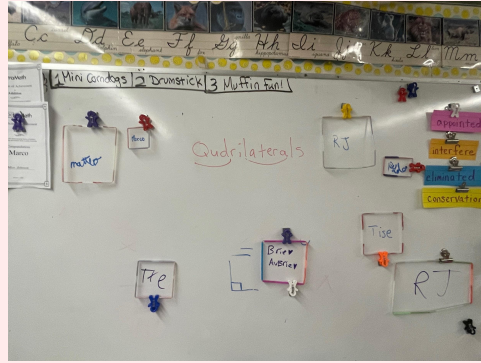
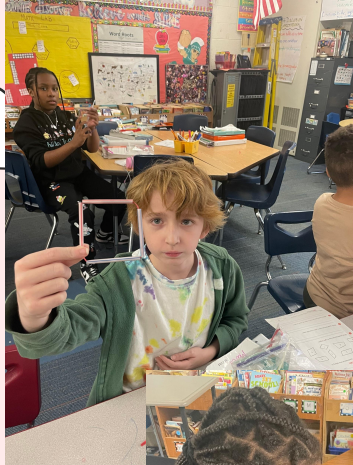
Ms. Culver

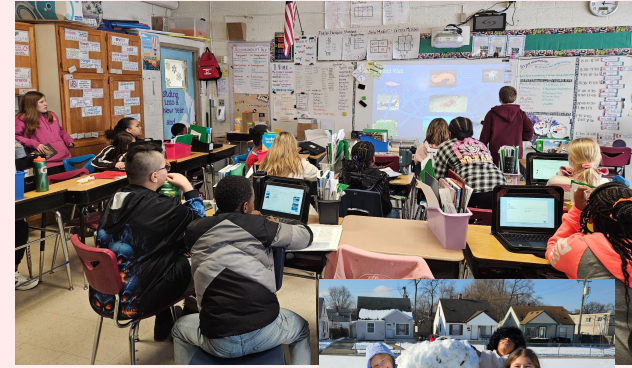
We had such fun before Christmas break making symmetrical designs using tangram shapes.
