The HPJHS is designed for 6th, 7th and 8th graders at Hazel Park Junior High School. This team offers an exciting introduction to the world of competitive swimming and diving!

What You'll Learn

Swimmers will master the fundamentals of each sport.

Work toward refining these skills to compete against other schools in Oakland/Macomb County.

Gain valuable experience that will benefit your future in high school swimming.

Don't miss out on this amazing opportunity to develop your athletic skills and be part of an awesome team!

• The team is open to all 6th, 7th, and 8th graders.

 For swimmers, the only requirement is to swim two lengths of the pool (50 yards) without stopping, touching the bottom or needing any other assistance.

•Must have a sports physical to participate: Physical on file dated after April 15, 2024. Athletes will not be allowed to participate in tryouts/practices until all items are turned in and completed.

• The season runs from March 31st to May 22nd with practices on Monday through Friday. The first week of practices will be tryouts.

• Competitions will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout the eight-week season

• Unlike in high school, boys and girls will compete against each other in all events. 6th graders will be in separate events from 7th and 8th graders.

 Swimmers will need to have a competition swimsuit, competitive swim goggles, and a swim cap. SwimOutlet.com is the best place to purchase all your swimming equipment online. Just like any other sport, having quality equipment will improve performance. ○ Girls should have a one piece; competition suit and boys should have a jammer or speedo. ○ Swimmers will need a pair of goggles. We recommend Arena Cobra Cores/Ultras or Speedo Vanquishers 2.0.

Practices are held at Hazel Park High School pool from 3pm – 5pm M
– F. Student are bus over to the High School; Parent must pick them up after practice.


