

M-STEP Reports

Please take some time to review this with your child. This test is important as it is a measure of the child's as well as the school's progress in teaching the state standards.

Dear Parent or Guardian.

As you know, Webb Elementary School has been implementing School-Wide positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (SWPBIS) which is a proactive approach to establishing the behavior supports and social culture needed for all students in a school to achieve social, emotional, and academic success.

This school year, we will be utilizing a behavior universal screener, Social, Academic, and Emotional Behavior Risk Screener, used by teachers that will help identify school-wide behavior and social-emotional supports that can support all students and will help identify students who may be having minor challenges in school, such as following rules and expectations to making friends. Our goal in using this universal screener is to identify school-wide instructional needs, inform the use of teacher-delivered strategies, and identify students who may need additional support.

The behavior universal screener is completed 3 times per year (October, January and March). Your child's classroom teacher will review the class roster and identify students who currently may be having difficulties in school. The information is kept confidential and only used to determine instructional needs at the classroom and individual student level. We will contact parents of children who have been selected to participate in a simple intervention focused on supporting the child in a proactive and positive manner.







