Report Cards

We apologize for the extra delay. With our new system there have been some technical difficulties with getting these printed. Report Cards will now go out with all students on Monday.

The students are given numbers to show their current progress:

4=Student working above grade level expectations

3=Student meeting grade level expectations

2=Student approaching but not meeting grade level expectations

1=Not meeting grade level expectations

We will also be sending home reports regarding your child's reading level and how you can help them at home (IRLA Report) as well as information about their reading and math achievement according the I-Ready assessments we give 3 times per year. Students in grades K-3 will receive IRIP reports that discuss reading progress and needs. Please let your child's teacher know if you have any questions.

Parking at Jardon

If you pick up students by car from Jardon, please do not park at the curb where the buses load. You will need to park in a parking spot, out of the way of the bus lane.

Holiday Baskets

We will again be collecting donations for Holiday Baskets at Webb. There is a district-wide effort to collect food for those in need. At Webb we will be collecting non-perishable potatoes - mashed, scalloped, etc. All donations can be sent in with your child to school. The winning classroom will receive a pizza party so be sure your child takes the items to the classroom to be counted first. If you are or know someone in need, applications to receive a holiday basket will be available in the school office starting November 4th. At this time, holiday baskets are only given to those families that live within the school district, but out of district families can inquire about help as there are other resources in the community that we can connect you with.

Life Club

We are offering an opportunity for your student to attend Life Club, on Tuesdays right after school until 4:45, to learn about the Bible. This is an after school club and not part of the regular district curriculum. There will be three separate sessions arranged by grade level. If you would like your children to attend the same session, please note the session you would prefer, and we will do our best to include all of them. Each student will only be able to attend one session.

Although the weather has taken a warm turn, we are getting closer to winter so we want to remind you about the importance of sending your child to school with warm jackets, etc. We try to go out for recess as much as possible so the students get some fresh air and exercise. The cutoff temperature is 20 degrees with wind chill factored in. Please make sure that your child brings appropriate gear to school to keep them warm during outside recess. If there is snow on the ground the students will ONLY be allowed to play on the playground if they have winter boots on. If they don't have boots they must stay on the sidewalk area. We do have some donated winter items if your child is in need - reach out to the school office to see if we have any items that would fit

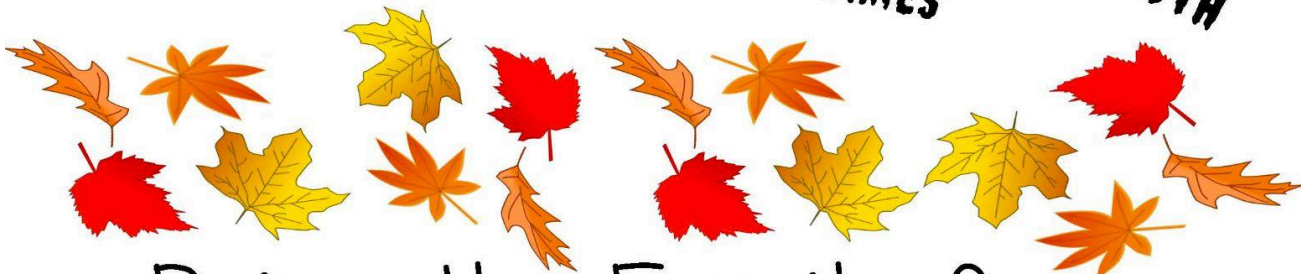

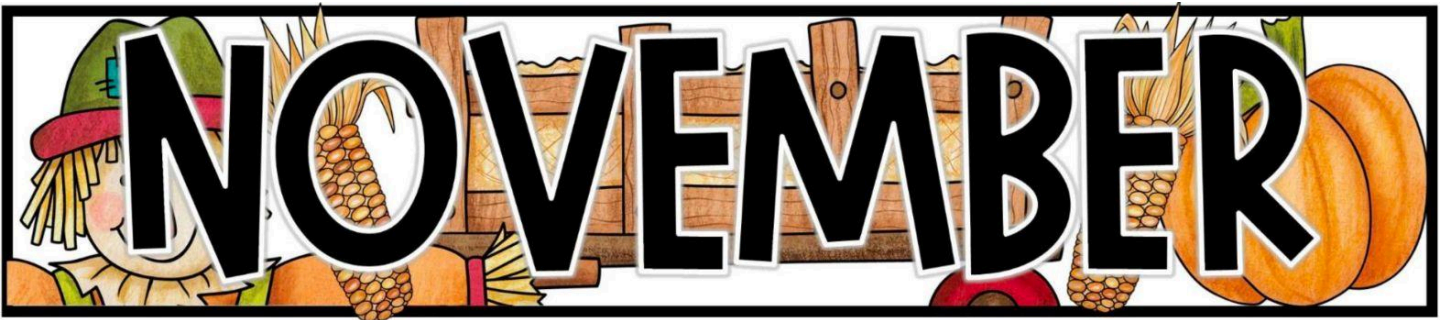

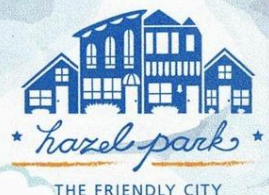
Tree Lighting begins at 6:00

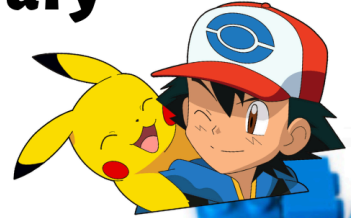
