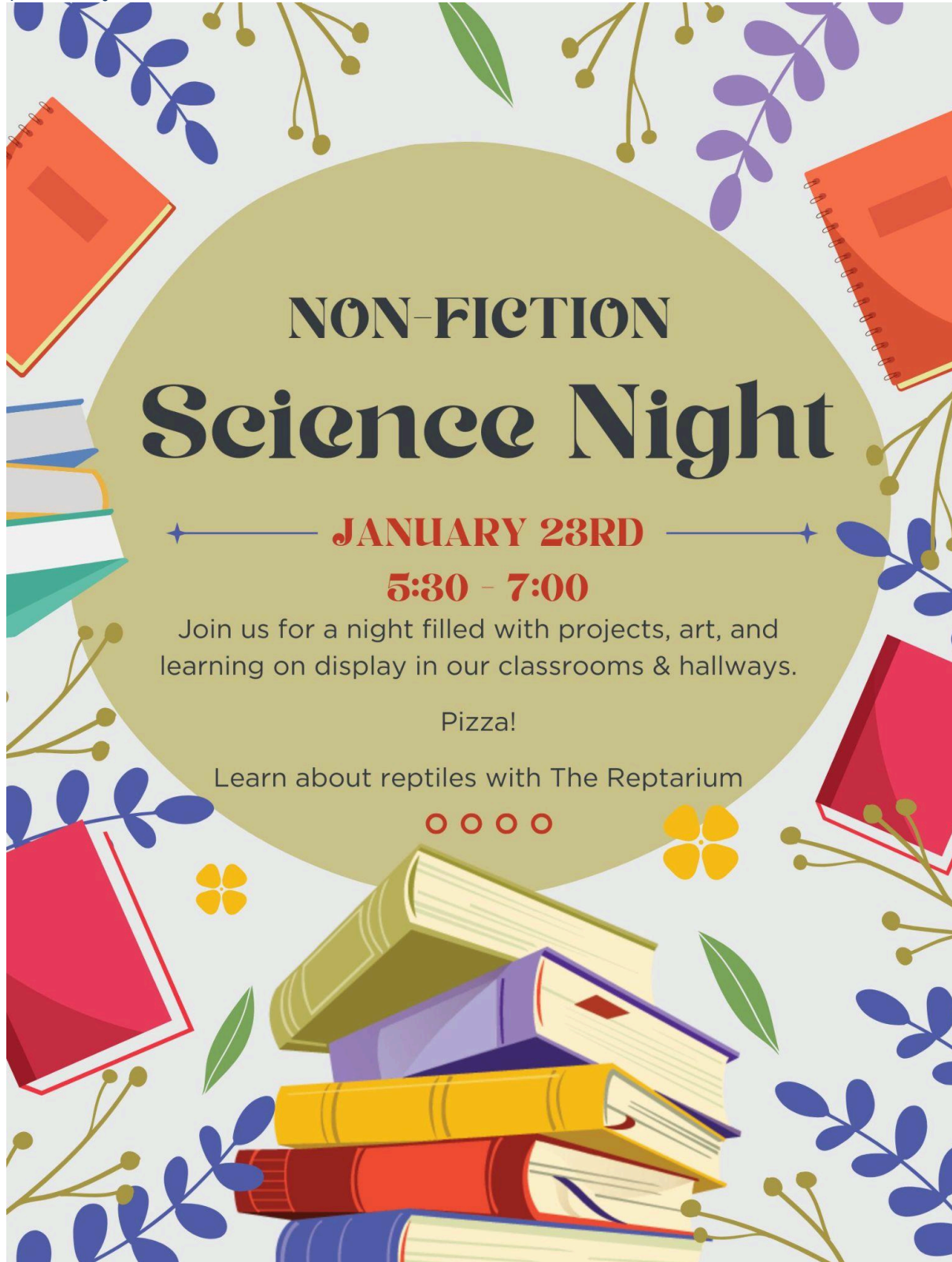


- **Auditions:** Wednesday, Jan. 15th 3:30- 4:30

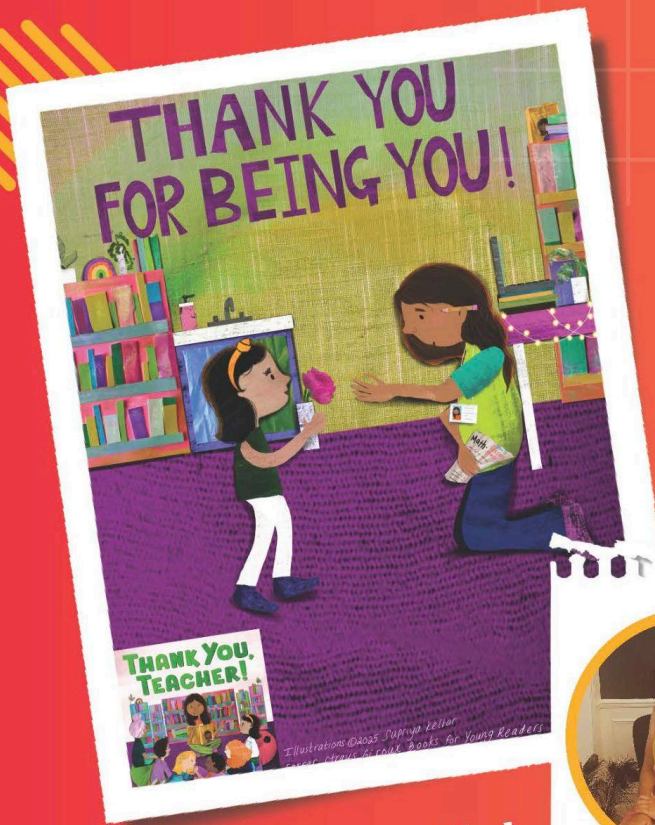
## Life Club

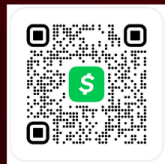

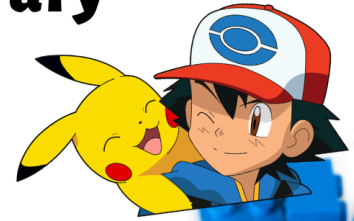
