Thank you to everyone for being patient with us as we moved into our new student information system, PowerSchool. There have been some bumps in the road, but we are getting better at using it every day and hopefully as we move into next year, it will be much more seamless. One thing we have noticed is that many accounts have very little to no emergency contacts. This may have occurred as we moved information over from MiStar or maybe they weren't filled in completely at registration.
