From the Principal


Dear Webb Families,

Michigan Child Protection Registry

Michigan families, especially minors, are increasingly targeted by advertisements promoting alcohol, tobacco, pornography, illegal drugs, and gambling through email, text messages, and social media platforms like Instagram, Snapchat, YouTube, Discord, TikTok, Twitch, and Twitter/X. Thankfully, the State of Michigan offers a free program to help stop these adult advertisements from reaching children. The Michigan Child Protection Registry is a free do-not-contact service that allows families to register their children's email addresses, phone numbers, and social media accounts to block these harmful messages. Signing up is quick and easy—just visit the Hazel Park Community Coalition (HPCC) website to enroll and enhance your family's online safety.
